A. Personal Details

All members should complete as much of this section as possible.

B. Training History

This section should contain full details of your training history, who your teachers were, how long you trained with each one, and what aspects of Chinese Internal Arts that you have studied. Please attach any supporting information, such as copies of Certificates etc., that you may have.

C. Information on School

Please include your School name (if you have one), the aspects of Chinese Internal Arts that you are teaching and those which you can also perform in a competent manner. Each aspect should be co-signed by your referring Instructor who is in current membership of the TCUGB. If this is not possible then you will be required to provide video evidence of the various skills you are conversant with, and zoom assessment may be required. Video(s) is required from all applicants.
