All Instructors must hold a qualification recognised by the TCUGB to deliver the activity they are teaching. We do not require a copy of the qualification, but in the event of a claim, reserve the right to request one.

All Instructors must disclose any claims or incidents likely to give rise claim occurring within the past 5 years;

All instructors teaching children and/or vulnerable adults must be DBS checked (or National equivalent);


All students should complete a PAR-Q prior to their first class and should not be allowed to take part if any pre-existing conditions are disclosed that may affect their ability to carry out the class activity – This does not apply to delivering Tai Chi Health classes to Schools; Youth Groups; or one-off taster sessions at Festivals; Fayre's and the like.

All classes must be run in accordance with the TCUGB recommendations and safety protocols;

Teaching areas should be risk assessed before each session and any defects found recorded and remedied prior to the class taking place.
