

The official return to outdoor activities 'BEST PRACTICE' NGB guidelines

Duty of Care and Risk Assessment - OUTDOORS

DUTY OF CARE IS A LEGAL AS WELL AS MORAL REQUIREMENT WHEN 'RETURNING TO OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES'.

To ensure that all reasonable steps are being taken and its duty of care is being discharged, and to the required standard of care, sports and physical activity providers should **consider ALL of the foregoing relating to indoor activities as part of their risk assessment process. Additionally, the following needs to be adhered to:**

- **Landowner's permission – instructors must seek permission from the landowner before setting up any outdoor classes and have with them any required permits needed to operate on that land.**
- **Ensure the land being utilised is 'fit for purpose'.**
