

## **Guide for Making Videos**

If you are applying to be an Instructor with the TCUGB then <u>video evidence of your skills is</u> <u>required</u> by the Technical Panel, to help them assess your application.

In this, the Technical Panel is looking for the basic principles, whatever style you practice/wish to teach, Tai Chi, Qigong, Internal Arts i.e., bagua or hsing-I.

To help the TP your video should:

- A. Be viewable on a standard landscape format screen
- B. Clearly show head and feet
- C. Demonstrate on a flat surface (where possible)
- D. Have a clean background (where possible)
- E. Wear light coloured clothing, allowing us to see body alignments well
- F. Try to choose a location with no (or low) background noise (i.e., no traffic), especially if you are submitting a teaching demo with verbal instructions that we need to hear
- G. Supply a You Tube or website link, where just a link can be sent to assessors to view a video, without a need to download videos
- H. Don't walk out of the shot
- I. Don't stand motionless for a lengthy period of time (while preparing to move)

Following these guidelines, will give you the opportunity to present your video for the best outcome.
